On March 30, 2024, at 12:38 pm, Officer Smith responded to the area of Susan Court for the report of a possible abandoned vehicle. Officer Smith located the vehicle, a 2012 Ford Focus, parked along the cul-de-sac. The vehicle was found to be unregistered and was impounded. Through the course of the investigation, it was determined that Ms. Jeimy Lobo-Martinez was commonly the operator of the vehicle and had an active warrant for her arrest for \$2,500.00 out of Roxbury, NJ. Officer Smith was able to locate Ms. Lobo-Martinez and placed her under arrest for the warrant.
