On April 21, 2024, at 3:29 am Officer Simonetti responded to Center Street for the report of a motor vehicle accident. When he arrived Officer Simonetti located the vehicle, a Nissan Sentra, in the roadway where it came to rest after striking a parked vehicle. Officer Simonetti made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Kelsey Chaplin. As Officer Simonetti spoke with Ms. Chaplin, he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage and observed that she appeared to be impaired. Officer Simonetti conducted field sobriety testing and subsequently placed Ms. Chaplin under arrest. She was transported to police headquarters where she was charged with DWI and Reckless Driving. Ms. Chaplin was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.
