Chapter 169-8. Vaccination and license requirements. No person shall own, keep, harbor or maintain any dog over seven months of age within the Township of Mount Olive unless such dog is vaccinated and licensed.

\* The State of New Jersey requires **written proof** of current rabies vaccination which must be good for the duration of the license issued making the cutoff date 11/01. **Written proof** of spaying or neutering is required by the state for price reduction. Please have this information when applying.

## How to license your dog or cat in Mt. Olive

There are three ways that you can license your pet for the first time (no late fees apply)

1. Visit [www.mtolivenjtwp.org](http://www.mtolivenjtwp.org) click "make a payment" go to Health Dept & Sanitation. Email [lferfecki@mtolivetwp.org](mailto:lferfecki@mtolivetwp.org) the state required copy of pet's rabies certificate and written proof of spay/neuter for \$3 discount. Fax (973)691-7681
2. Visit the Health Dept. in the Municipal Building and register your pet at the counter.
3. Mail application with required documents to Mt Olive Twp. Animal Control at P.O. Box 450 Budd Lake, NJ 07828 or place in the drop box located in the municipal parking lot on the left upon entrance.

As a courtesy a renewal notice is mailed January 1<sup>st</sup> for dogs and April 1<sup>st</sup> for cats provided the pet was licensed the prior year.
