Community Connections is a referral-based support program that is run by the Morris County Sheriff's Office and partnered with the Successful Transition and Re-Entry Program (STAR) through the Office of Temporary Assistance (OTA), The Mental Health Association (MHA) and Center for Addiction, Recovery, Education and Success (CARES). Through the Sheriff's online website, QR code or contact number, a client that is court involved can submit a referral form indicating that they need services.
